**Sanchez battered
as United cruise it**

ALEXIS Sanchez suffered a rough ride on his debut as Manchester United cruised past Yeovil in the FA Cup last night.

The United new-boy was on the receiving end of some roughhouse treatment dished out by the hosts in the fourth-round tie.

But the Chilean striker, who suffered a mixed bag before being replaced in the 72nd minute, had the last laugh as Jose Mourinho's men avoided a banana skin.

League Two Yeovil came flying out of the blocks but early chances went begging. And United punished

them in ruthless fashion as Yeovil were blown away.

Indecision from Glovers defender Tom James saw Marcus Rashford pounce in the 41st minute following a break from Sanchez.

Sanchez's run and perfectly weighted pass set up Ander Herrera for the second in the 61st minute before Jesse Lingard added a third.

Fellow sub Romelu Lukaku completed the rout by turning home Marcos Rojo's cross in the dying minutes.
