

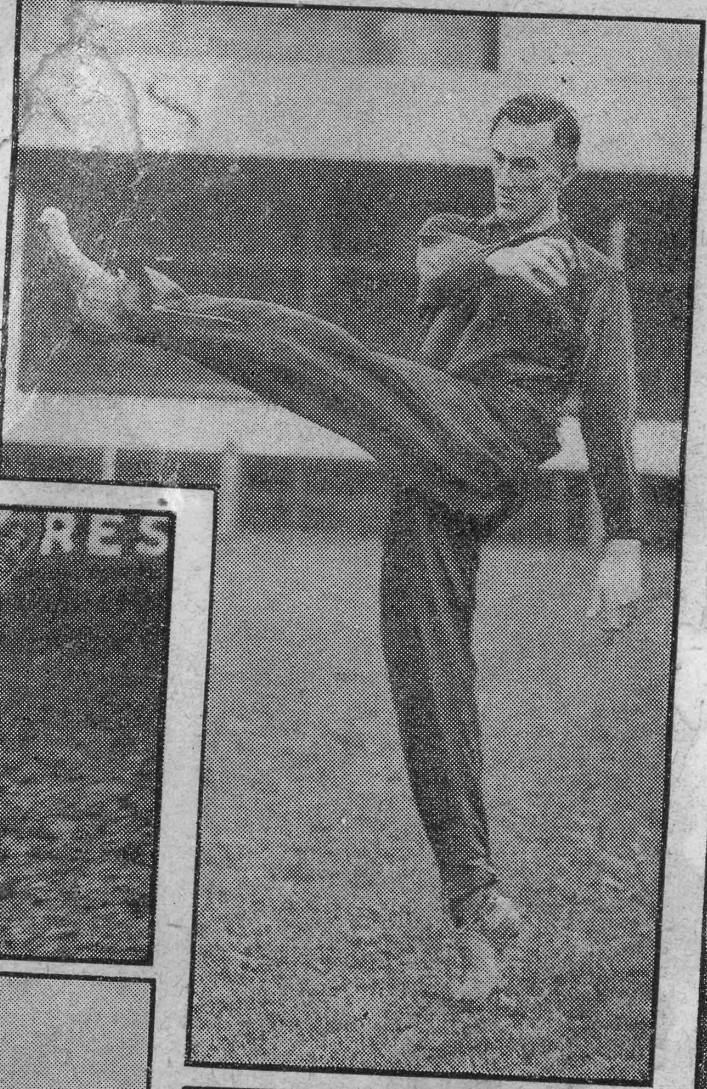
# STURDY YEOMEN OF YEOVIL
