

YEOVIL AND BURY CUP FIGHTERS



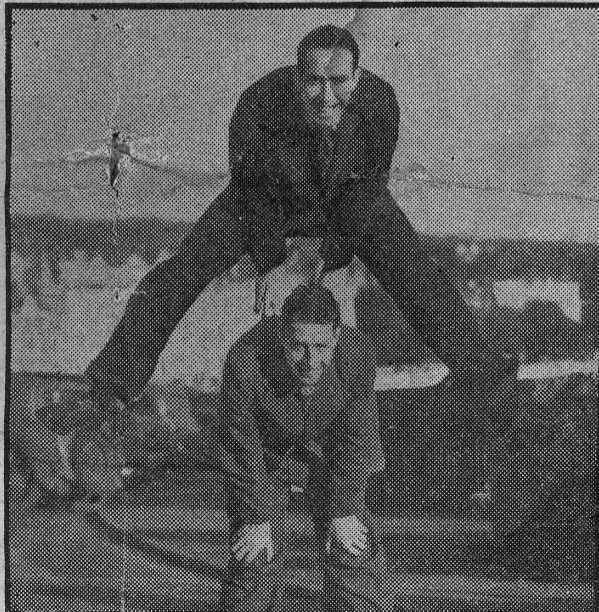
