Glovers climb to Championship with play-off win

YEOVIL Town have made history by defying the odds to reach the power Championship for the first time in their 118-year history.

The Glovers avenged demons of six years ago by beating Brentford 2-1 in their second ever League One play-off final at Wembley.

Paddy Madden gave Yeovil the dream start with his 24th goal of the season on six minutes before Dan Burn - left-towered above three markers to nod home a second shortly before half time.

Harlee Dean threatened a Bees' come back with a header minutes after the restart but a combination of resolute defending and supreme keeping from the Glovers allowed them to hold on for an unforgettable victory.

This week's *Western Gazette* contains 32 pages of pictures and reports marking the club's achievements. A Glovers' director outlines his hopes for the future, whilst League Managers' Association League One boss of the year Gary Johnson is encouraged to sign a new deal.
