

Cotton predicts great future for Forinton

TERRY Cotton knows a bit about strikers. He hit 83 goals for Yeovil Town and is still the club's eighth highest post-war goalgetter. So when he says he thinks Howard Forinton will "go all the way" it is not a compliment to be treated lightly.

After watching the 21-year-old score twice in the second half to give Yeovil a 3-1 win over Staines on Tuesday, Cotton, now Graham Roberts' No 2, enthused: "His body strength is phenomenal. And if he can play like this now, just imagine what he will be like when he starts full-time training with Birmingham City".
