Tonight's visitors have undergone a managerial change and introduced a new trainer (none other than our old friend Nick Collins) since their last visit to Huish. We extend a hearty welcome back to Nick but naturally hope his proteges go away pointless. An unpredictable side, their line up is as follows:—

**Prodger** (goal-keeper). Signed from Dartford. He is well-known in Yeovil as he represented the R.A.S.C. and Yeovil League whilst doing National Service at Houndstone. Is also a County cricketer.

**Bannister** (right-back). Signed this season from Aldershot for whom he appeared regularly. Captains the side.

**McDonald** (left-back). Given excellent service during his five seasons with the visitors. Has also assisted Crystal Palace and Kettering.

**Curry** (inside-left). Was in Colchester's Cup team that trounced us at Huish. Signed from Chelmsford in December.

**Hunter** (outside-left). Another newcomer, signed from Carlisle during the close season.
