For tonight's game Wisbech include their latest acquisition, Graham Ward, secured from Cambridge United in exchange for Graham Laurence and a fee. Ward it is hoped will strengthen the goal-scoring abilities of the forward line. Pen Pictures are appended :—

**Chandler** (goal-keeper). Secured from Cambridge City during the close season. Previously assisted Bristol Rovers and Swindon.

**Phillips** (right-back). In his second season as a professional. Joined the visitors from Leytonstone.

**Porter** (left-back). A protege of local football and made his way to the First team via 'A' team and Reserves. Has now made over 100 First team appearances.

**Noon** (right-half). A recent signing from Bradford City, previously assisted Notts County.

**Jayes** (centre-half). Joined the club from Ramsgate having had League experience with Leicester and Mansfield. Strong in the tackle combined with good distribution.

**McDonald** (left-half). Ex-Scottish International whose league clubs were Sunderland and Notts Forest.

**Dixon** (outside-right). A close season capture from Northampton Town. Has also played with Cardiff and Newport.

**Ward** (inside-right). Making his first appearance, he is reputed to be an up and coming forward with ball control and scoring power.

**Hill** (centre-forward). Another player developed from local school football via the 'A' team and Reserves.

**Morton** (inside-left). On loan from Peterborough since December, he is proving a clever inside-forward.

**Flatt** (outside-left). A local discovery, in his second season as a professional. Attracting the Scouts by his consistent displays.
